Meeting at SIMPLE PALATE called to order by President John Grigg at 7:30 PM

ANNOUNCMENTS: Moment of Silence for Jim Lucero. Ray Dong had a recap of some memories and his accomplishments.

Guests tonight: Dave Mabry from Box 21. Dave had a discussion on Box 21 at the end of the meeting. April 2023 MEETING MINUTES: Motion to approve as printed in newsletter, Barry Pray; second, Rich Falcinelli; motion carried. TREASURER'S REPORT – MARIO MARALDO: Mario Maraldo submitted the treasurer's report, noting no expenses. Mario will mail checks to reimburse people who presented at Autorama. Motion to accept Treasurer's Report, Ray Dong; second Rich Falcinelli; motion carried.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT – NANCY SPANICH: Nancy's monthly report finds: 63 primary, 18 primary family, 2 honorary, 14 lifetime, 3 lifetime family for a total of 100. Memberships keep coming in! 21 new members included in total. PUBLICITY – TINA WILSON: No Issues – as always needs content.

ENTERTAINMENT – Dave XXXX of Box 21. Dave discussed how he began in the rescue business, some more interesting rescue events and some of the people he has crossed paths with in his time in Rescue. OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. NEW RACE SEARCH COMMITTEE: A. Belleville Lake 24-25June 2023, Steve Linn reported the following:
 - a. BYC in the process of finalizing crane services with Laramie and Alingham.
 - b. Golf carts will be available to move people around.
 - c. Outside course markers have been finalized
 - d. Volunteers are needed to support the event.
 - i. Will require assistance to remove guard rail sections and pit set up on Friday. Will need to match mark guardrails so they can be repositioned.
 - ii.Local boats need to be positioned on Friday. Will have a 10' space between crane and guard rail.
 - iii. Need an assistant Risk Manager to work with Barry (referee) and Race Director. Need someone to step forward for this. This person needs to take an APBA test. This is critical to the success of the regatta.

Phil Goddell; insurance application submitted, updates expected to be needed; working on boat count, with Rich Falcinelli's help.

Officials for Belleville - Referee Barry Pray, Asst Ref Jack Meyer, Inspector is TBD – Rich Falcinelli has taken the test. Scorer is Jennifer Grigg with assistance, Race Director is ?, Pit Manager is Sam and Rachael with Ray. John Bridge Vintage Rep.

Vintage has 5 boats firm. Would like to have 10-12. Vintage racers need to contact John Bridge prior to Regatta. There is \$200 tow money but racers must make a lap. There may be a couple larger boats available for exhibitions to try out the course.

Mott Regatta 2023; Had a Zoom meeting with Genesee Twp Supervisor Daniel Eashoo. Also Fire Department reps were present at meeting. All paperwork signed by the park to authorize the Regatta. Spoke of how to crate a border between the spectators and the race course.

Nothing new with White Lake Township – Ray will be following up mid-May.

Conversation will begin again with Ann Arbor Jaycees and Ford Lake Park in September when the Jaycee busy season is over.

New Business:


Simple Palate closed week of July 4, our July Meeting will be July 12. Normal time.






